CONSULTATION WITH FIREARM DEALERS, MANUFACTURERS ON THE IMPLEMENTATION OF E-SUBMISSION SOLUTION IN TERMS OF SECTION 39 OF THE FIREARMS CONTROL ACT, 2000 (ACT NO. 60 OF 2000)

- A.1. The implementation of the interim e-Submission Solution is currently in process. This solution will enhance service delivery and alleviate the challenges experienced by the Central Firearms Register (CFR) as opposed to the manual capturing of the SAPS 350 forms.
 - 2. In pursuit of the foregoing, provinces are required to schedule and facilitate a formal briefing with the commercial agents, in which LAWtrust will conduct the enrolment of the Responsible and/ or Designated persons on a face-to-face basis.
 - 3. It is required that the following requirements with regards to enrolment of the Commercial Agents be communicated to same prior to the overview presentation:
 - 3.1 Each Agent will be issued with a Token and a Certificate at their own cost;
 - 3.2 Original SA Identity Book/ Card is required;
 - 3.3 Each Agent will sign a LAWtrust Subscriber Agreement and the SAPS ID Consent form;
 - 3.4 Laptop will be required for enrolment; and
 - 3.5 Commercial Agents that are unable to attend the Overview and Enrolment session, will need to arrange an appointment with LAWtrust at their offices.

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4. LAWtrust together with a team from the Central Firearms Register and TMS will be visiting various provinces as per the schedule below:
